

**PUBLIC NOTICE
SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO
CITY OF PITTSBURGH'S ONE YEAR CONSOLIDATED ACTION PLAN
(APRIL 1, 2008-MARCH 31, 2009)**

Notice is hereby given that the following substantial change has been made in the City of Pittsburgh's 2008 One Year Consolidated Action Plan to include the Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP). The Homelessness Prevention Fund was created under Title XII of Division A of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Recovery Act). The purpose of the Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP) is to provide homelessness prevention assistance to households who would otherwise become homeless-many due to the economic crisis- and to provide assistance to rapidly re-house persons who are homeless as defined by section 103 of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act. The City of Pittsburgh will receive \$6,848,936 of Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP) funds.
