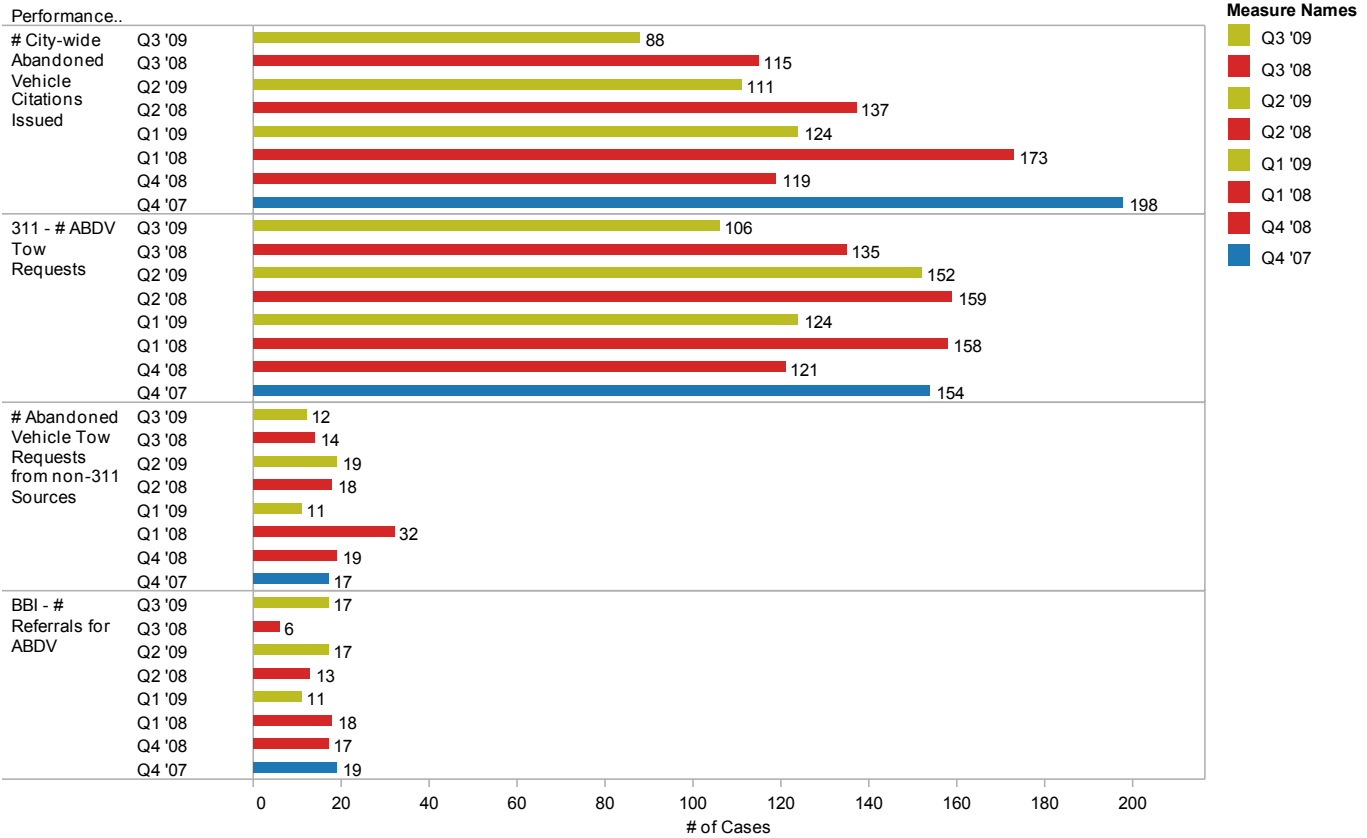


Comparing Abandoned Vehicle Management



Mayor Ravenstahl AGENDA GOAL: Safe and Clean Neighborhoods - Reduce the environment for crime; Increase civic involvement and transparency.

DESCRIPTION: Abandoned Vehicles are a public safety issue and the responsibility primarily of the Police Department with the assistance of the Code Enforcement division of the Bureau of Building Inspection (BBI) if a vehicle is on private property. A vehicle is defined as abandoned if it does not have a proper license plate, registration, or inspection sticker. At present, Abandoned Vehicle information is not neighborhood or Council district specific.

ANALYSIS: The number of Citations issued has decreased by more than 10% for the second consecutive quarter. Citizens continue to reduce the reporting of abandoned vehicles to 311. Beginning in 2009 each Police Zone has become more on the look out for abandoned vehicles within their zone of neighborhoods.
