## I. EDUCATIONAL OPTIONS

**Recommendation 1:** Continue to develop a portfolio of programs and schools to ensure that all students graduate ready for post-secondary education, training, and/or employment.

**Recommendation 2:** Continue to promote and use The Pittsburgh Promise™ as an incentive strategy across alternative programs.

**Recommendation 3:** Transition students to post-secondary education, training, and/or employment.



## II. POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

**Recommendation 1:** The Pathways Planning Team advises that current Pittsburgh Public School policies, some with concurrent procedures, be examined for possible revision.

**Recommendation 2:** Teachers and administrators together can address the dropout issue by close adherence to the ABC early warning indicators: Attendance, Behavior, and Course Failure.

## III. STAKEHOLDERS

**Recommendation 1:** The dedicated Stakeholder Advisory Group that has met to provide input and guidance to the Graduate Pittsburgh Summit and the Pathways Planning Team Members should continue their involvement with this valuable project. The Advisory Group Membership also should be expanded.

**Recommendation 2:** Stakeholders should provide targeted, strategic academic remediation for students who have fallen behind or who have arrived at post secondary education, training, or employment without the necessary skills to be successful.
