

## Weatherization Program

\*Not applicable to homes with prior weatherization or in violation of County Health and Safety regulations.

### Services Provided

- Replace cracked or broken glass in windows
- Caulk/weather-strip around windows
- Re-glaze windows
- Install insulation blanket around hot water tank
- Install insulation wrap around exposed pipes
- Insulate attic area
- Safety check on heating plant and hot water tank

- Family member living in the home receiving SSI or AFDC is automatically accepted regardless of income (must apply with Weatherization Department)

### Application Process

- 12 months of income history
- Eligible if receiving LIHEAP crisis and/or cash assistance

### Customer Prioritization

- Households will be prioritized based upon LIHEAP status and energy consumption.
- LIHEAP clients and high consumers will have priority over non-LIHEAP, moderate to low consumers.

## **Identification Requirements**

\*These requirements apply to visiting all LIHEAP Cash Assistance and LIHEAP Crisis locations.

- Social Security Cards – Must have a card representing every member of the household. This applies to all applicants.
- Deeds or Tax Receipts – This applies to home owner landlords or home owner occupant(s).
- Lease or Rent Receipts – This applies to renting tenant(s).
- Utility Bills – Must be most recent and applies to all applicants. (Gas, Electric or Water Bills are not required if utilities are included in rent).
